### III. Chairperson's Remarks

a. Lt. Governor Stratton provided an overview of the day's meeting and addresses the importance of October as it is Domestic Violence Awareness Month and Breast Cancer

Awareness Month. Lt. Governor Stratton shared the recent work from Governor Pritzker who signed a packet of Domestic Violence bills in late August providing additional resources and protections to women who are victims. Additionally, Lt. Governor Stratton informed the council the office is working with committee chairs to draft the upcoming council report. Lastly, Lt. Governor Stratton addressed the inequalities that still exist between women's and men's sports. She thanked the members of the council for the work they are doing because on her travels around the state, people are taking notice and know they have advocates on the council.

### IV. New Business

- a. Committee Updates
  - i. Dr. Vidhya Prakash provided an update on the Health and Healthcare Committee, she thanked Lt. Governor Stratton for convening the Health Equity Summit held on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and reiterated the need to enhance both quantitative and qualitative data collection on social determinants of health to promote health equity. Dr. Vidhya Prakash also shared that the committee organized a briefing for Dr. Ngozi Ezike from IDPH on October 4<sup>th</sup> where they presented their findings. The committee plans to compare its findings from the Health Equity Summit with the data from the COVID-19 Equity Task Force to form policy specific categories.
  - ii. Cynthia Orizaba provides an update on the Gender-Based Violence Committee, she notes that the committee is working on developing a Know Your Rights Campaign webinar series to be launched in 2022.
  - iii. Jackie Matthews provided an update on the Academic and Economic Opportunity Committee, she discusses work the committee has been doing with helping the Girls' Committee investigate the issues that committee is working on, specifically access to childcare. Jackie Matthews also notes the Girls' Committee is exploring ways to involve girls in the state who are not members.
  - iv. Maaria Mozaffar provided an update on the Leadership and Inclusion Committee, first thanking Lt. Governor Stratton for her leadership. The committee is working on the Girls Lead mentorship program and drafting a letter to invite legislators to participate in this mentorship program for young girls.
    - 1. Lt. Governor Stratton states she would be open to participating in this program and notes other constitutional officers may be interested.

  - Lt. Governor Stratton thanked her for her service and stated she had seen an article
    days prior about the women veterans honor flight and expressed interest in a postflight conversation with Rochelle Crump and other women veterans who were on
    the flight.
